I consider the conflict in the United States about the teaching of biological evolution completely unnecessary. My metaphysics teacher in college was W. Norris Clark, S.J., who taught us that the scientific arguments for God’s existence (the Big Bang, evolution, and origin of life) are not as good as the metaphysical arguments based on free will and the conscious knowledge of human beings.
